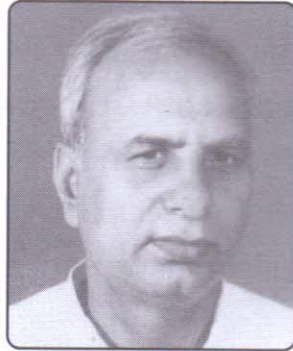

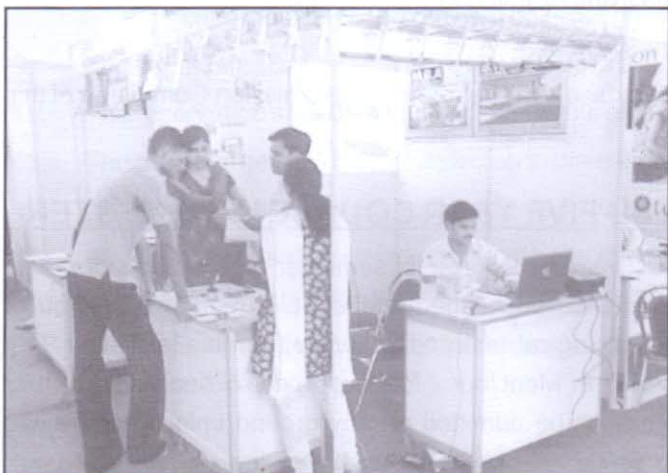
Library

RULES FOR ADMISSION TO LL.B. 1st SEMESTER (THREE YEAR COURSE)

1. The students shall be admitted in the LL.B three year 1st Semester on the basis of marks obtained on the academic record computed out of 50 (herein-after called Academic Index) plus marks secured out of 50 in the admission test, group discussion, psychological test and interview. The interview (hereinafter called Test Index) to be conducted by this college, total of which shall form Merit Index for purpose of deciding the order of preference for making the admission. No candidate shall be admitted on any ground unless he/she has appeared at the prescribed admission test, group discussion, psychological test and interview.
2. A candidate will be eligible for admission to LL.B 1st semester (three year course) if he/she has obtained bachelor's degree recognized by Lucknow University with 10+2+3 system and secured not less than 45% marks at graduate level, 40% marks for SC/ST candidates
3. Admission to LL.B. 1st Semester will be made strictly on the basis of the merit list prepared according to para 1. The percentage of the marks obtained in the qualifying examination plus the weightage, if any for which the candidate is entitled as per University rules. The percentage will be calculated up to three figures after decimal point.
4. To determine the merit for admission of such candidates who have secured equal marks in the qualifying examination, the percentage of marks secured by the candidates at the Intermediate or equivalent examination will be the determining factor of merit for admission.
5. The weightage for girls shall be 5% marks obtained in qualifying examination.
6. Reservation and weightage shall be applied as per University rules.
7. All disputes regarding interpretation of provisions of these rules shall be referred to Admission Committee of this college whose decision shall be final and binding.

RULES FOR ADMISSION TO LL.B INTEGRATED FIVE YEAR COURSE 1st SEMESTER

1. The students shall be admitted in the LL.B Integrated Five Year Course 1st semester on the basis of marks obtained on academic record computed out of 50 (hereinafter called 'Academic Index') plus marks secured out of 50 in the written admission test, group discussion, psychological test and interview (hereinafter called 'Test Index') to be conducted by this college, total of which shall form 'Merit Index' for the purpose of deciding the order of preference for making the admission. No candidate shall be admitted on any ground unless he/she has appeared at the prescribed admission test, group discussion, psychological test and interview.
2. A candidate will be eligible for admission to the LL.B Integrated Five Year Course 1st semester, if he/she has completed Intermediate or equivalent examination recognized by Lucknow University with 10+2 system and has secured not less than 45% marks at Intermediate level. However for SC/ST candidates minimum percentage will be 40.
3. The marks of the Academic Index will be calculated out of 50 after normalization (Marks obtained in all subjects in which a candidate has appeared in the qualifying examination will be taken into account for calculating the percentage of marks).
4. In order to remove disparity that exists between the marks awarded to the candidate by different examining authorities/boards in the country, a system of "Normalization will be adopted. Under the normalization procedure Statistically the first rank student of one board will be equal to that of the first rank of the other board. As such the first rank student of each board will be considered to have obtained 100% marks and the aggregate marks of all other students from that board will be normalized with reference to the aggregate marks obtained by the first rank student to the board. For example, if the aggregate marks of the first rank student of a board is 96%, his normalized aggregate is 100% and if a student from the same board has obtained 84% marks, then his normalized percentage will be $(84 \times 100) / 96 = 87.5$ / The college shall procure on its own the percentage of marks

obtained by the first rank student of Central Board of Secondary Education. Council of Indian School Certificate and U.P. Board for the purpose of normalization of marks.

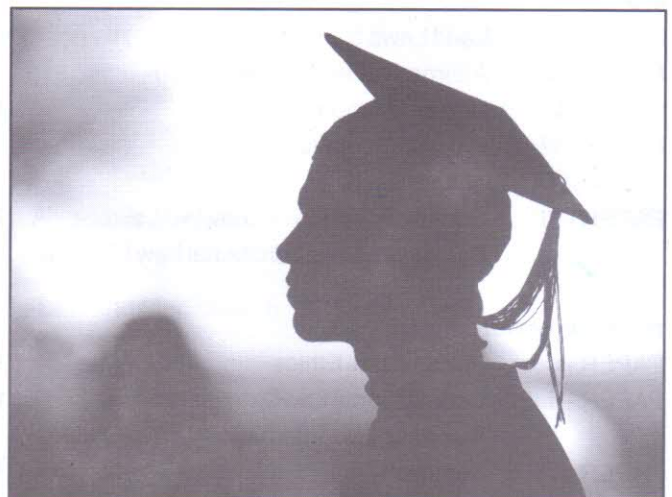
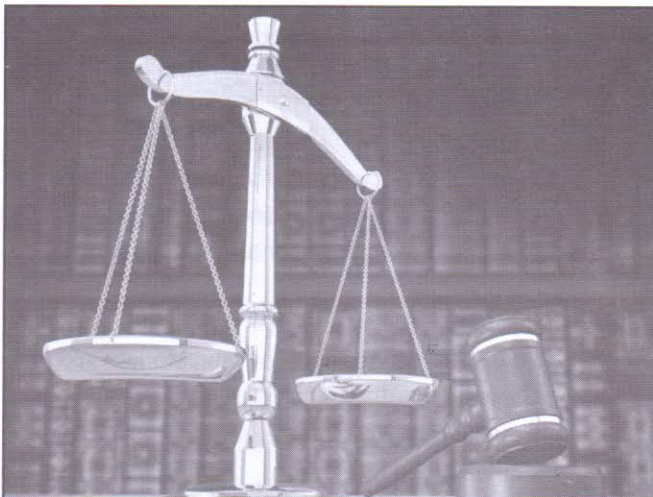
5. The Admission Test, Group discussion, Psychological Test and Interview will be conducted separately by the college for admission to LL.B. Hons.

6. ADMISSION TEST

The candidates will have to appear in the admission test. The test questions shall be based on the course prescribed for Intermediate examination of U.P. Board in following subjects. The test will be objective type of 75 minutes duration:-

(1) General Knowledge (2) General Hindi (3) General English (4) Mental ability

7. The candidates belonging to the General and OBC categories should not be above 20 years of age on 16th July in the year of Admission. However SC/ST and OBC candidates should not be above 22 years of age.
8. If two or more candidates have secured equivalent marks/rank in the merit index, in that case the merit for admission will be determined as follows:-
- (i) First preference will be given to the candidate who secures higher percentage of marks at Intermediate or equivalent examination.
 - (ii) If the Intermediate marks are same, in such cases first preference will be given to the candidate who secures higher percentage of marks at High School or equivalent examination.
 - (iii) If the marks obtained at the Intermediate and High School or equivalent examination are the same, in that case the older candidate will be given priority.
9. The candidate shall be entitled to weightage (if any) of the combined merit.
10. The reservation shall be given as permissible under the University rules.
11. The percentage shall be calculated up to three digits after decimal point.
12. College reserves the right to cancel any admission at any stage.
13. All disputes regarding interpretation of rules related to the LL.B. Integrated Five Year admission shall be referred to Admission Committee of college and whose decision shall be final and binding.
14. All the legal matters/disputes pertaining to the LL.B Integrated Five Year admission shall be subject to the Lucknow Judicature only.

Ordinance for Promotion, Exemption, Back Paper including Rules for Improvement etc. to be effective from Academic Session 2015-16.

LL.B. (Three Year : Six Semester) and LL.B (Integrated) (Five Year : Ten Semester) Programme.

1. The Three year degree course in Law, namely, Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) shall be divided in Six Semesters while the LL.B. (Integrated) Five year degree course in Law, namely, Bachelor of Laws shall be divided in Ten Semesters.
 2. **Course Duration**- A Student shall be allowed to complete the L.L.B. Three year degree course in maximum of five years and L.L.B. (Integrated) Five year degree course in maximum of Seven years. If he fails to pass the examination during this period he/she shall be deemed to have abandoned the course.
 3. The pattern of question paper/viva-voce shall be such as laid down by the examination committee, University of Lucknow from time to time.
 4. In every Semester in each paper/practical, as the case may be maximum marks shall be 100 while minimum pass marks in each paper shall be 40% individually and 48% in aggregate i.e., total of all papers, as the case may be of that Semester taken together.
 5. Division shall be awarded on the combined result of examinations of all the Semesters. Successful students who obtain 48% or above marks and below 60% of the total marks obtained shall be placed in the SECOND DIVISION and those who obtain 60% or above of the total marks shall be placed in the FIRST DIVISION.
 6. **Grace Marks** : Students may be given five marks as grace marks in individual paper or in aggregate, as the case may be, if these grace marks enable him to pass the examination of the Semester.
 7. **Promotion** : A Student who has secured 40% marks in aggregate and has failed in a maximum of four papers of Semester I shall be promoted to Semester II. A Student shall be promoted from Semester II to Semester III if he/she clears all papers of Semester II securing 40% marks in individual paper and 48% marks in aggregate.
A Student shall be promoted from Semester II to Semester III if he/she clears all papers of Semester I securing 40% marks in individual paper and 48% marks in aggregate and has failed in maximum of four papers of Semester II.
Explanation - A student shall be promoted from Odd Semesters to Even Semesters under the following conditions :-
 - (i) If a student has secured 40% marks in aggregate and has failed in a maximum of four papers of Odd Semesters shall be promoted to next Semester.
 - (ii) Student shall be promoted from odd Semester to even Semester if he/she has failed in one paper of odd Semester and three papers of even Semester. Students shall be promoted from odd Semester to even Semester if he/she has failed in two papers of odd Semester and two papers of even Semester.
 - (iii) A Student who has secured 40% marks in aggregate and has failed in maximum four papers of previous Semester shall be promoted from odd Semester to even Semester and from even Semester to odd Semester.
 8. **Back Paper** : A Student will be allowed to appear in Back Paper examination in maximum four papers of any Semester of the course in which he/she has failed to obtain 40% marks in individual paper but has obtained minimum of 40% marks in aggregate of total marks.
 9. **Exemption** : A Student who has failed to secure 40% marks in aggregate in every Semester and has failed in more than four paper shall be allowed to appear in all papers in the concerned semester as an exempted candidate. A student shall be allowed two consecutive chances to appear as an exempted candidate in the concerned semester examination. If a candidate has failed to avail the opportunity his chance shall be treated as he has availed the opportunity. Exempted students can avail the opportunity for appearing in the Back Paper examination of concerned Semester as admissible to regular student.
 10. **Improvement** : A student shall be allowed to reappear in two papers for improving his marks/percentage after passing final semester examination in the next concerned examination. If a candidate has failed to avail the opportunity in the next concerned examination, his chance shall be treated as he/she has availed the opportunity. But this facility will be available to those candidates only who pass all semester examinations in one attempt without availing the Back Paper facility. However, the inter-se merit of the candidates shall be determined on the basis of marks obtained in the First examination.
 11. There shall be 15 days preparation period between the declaration of examination schedule and actual date of commencement of examination.
 12. If student has passed final Semester examination of the course but has failed in two papers of any previous semester and the maximum period is over, in such circumstances on the recommendation of H.O.D/Dean, the Vice-Chancellor may grant one more opportunity to clear the Back Papers or he may refer the matter to examination committee.
- All disputes regarding interpretation of provisions of this Ordinance shall be referred to the Examination Committee of the University whose decision shall be final.

RULES FOR (INTEGRATED) FIVE YEAR COURSE (EXTRACT FROM ORDINANCE 2017-18)

2. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION :

- 2.1 A candidate will be eligible for admission on LL.B. (Integrated) Five Years Degree Course if he/she has completed Intermediate for equivalent examination recognized by recognized Board with 10+2 system and has secured not less than 45% marks at Intermediate level. However, for SC/ST candidate minimum percentage of marks will be 40%.
- 2.2 Admission to the LL.B. (Integrated) Five Years Degree Course will be strictly on the basis of merit prepared according to percentage of marks obtained in the entrance examination conducted by University of Lucknow provided that weight age and reservations shall be given as permissible under University Rules.

3. ATTENDANCE

No student of LL.B. (Integrated) Five Years Degree Course shall be allowed to take the end semester examination if the students concerned has not attended minimum of 70% of the classes held as also the moot court room exercise, tutorials and practical conducted in the subject taken together.

Provided that if a student for any exceptional reasons failed to attend 70% of the classes held in any subject, the Dean of the University or the Principal of the Centre of Legal Education, as the case may be, may allow the student to take the test if the student concerned attended at least 65% of the classes held.

12. EXAMINATION

- 12.1 In every compulsory and optional papers there shall be an Internal assessment and End Semester Examination divided in 30% & 70%.
- 12.2 The Internal Assessment shall be of 30 marks having following components:
 - (a) Assignment 10 marks
 - (b) Presentation 10 marks
 - (c) Unit Test 10 marks
- 12.3 In the end of semester an end term examination of 70 marks covering the full syllabus of paper concerned shall be conducted.
- 12.4 In Ninth and Tenth Semester taken together there will be two seminar papers as detailed out in Schedule II. In Seminar Paper Student shall have to select any one topic on prescribed subjects and submit a synopsis to Panel of Teachers of Faculty to be approved and permitted to write and submit a written submission. The assessment shall comprise 70% for Written Submission and 30% for viva voce. The topic must have introduction, research questions, hypothesis, research methodology, research tool, research plan and research findings. The study may be doctrinal or non-doctrinal. Faculty members shall supervise the work of students.
- 12.5 In Tenth Semester paper II entitled as "Clinical Legal Education" for Part A there shall be an end term examination of 50 marks. For Part B there shall be written submission and viva voce.
- 12.6 There shall be an examination at the end of each semester of LL.B. (Integrated) Five Years Degree Course. Every student registered in any semester shall be eligible to appear in the concerned examination of the respective semester subject to be attendance requirements as prescribed by the Bar Council of India and the University ad calculated on the semester basis.

13. Grace Marks : Students may be given five marks as grace marks in individual papers as the case may be, if these grace marks enable him to pass the examination of that semester.

14. PROMOTION & RE-REGISTRATION FOR EXAMINATION :

- 14.1 A candidate, who having pursued a regular course of study fails to appear at the main examination of LL.B. (Integrated) Five years Degree Course of any semester held for regular students or having appeared fails to pass in any of the courses (First and Second semesters taken together) may appear in the course (in both semester) in which he did not appear or has failed, at any subsequent examination, held as back logger or at supplementary examination held for regular students without undergoing a regular course of study in subsequent year in accordance with the provisions of these Ordinances.
- 14.2 The marks obtained by a candidate in the previous examination in respect of a paper in which he/she has secured less than minimum pass marks, shall be substituted by the marks obtained by him in the subsequent examination in respect of the concerned papers.
- 14.3 A student who has secured 40% of marks in aggregate and has failed in maximum of four papers of Semester I shall be promoted to Semester II. A student shall be promoted from Semester II to Semester III, if he/she clears all papers of Semester II securing 40% marks in individual paper and 48% marks in aggregate.
A student shall be promoted from semester II to Semester III if he/she clears all papers of Semester I securing 40% marks in individual paper and 48% marks in aggregate and failed in maximum of four papers of semester II.
- 14.4 **BACK PAPER:** A student shall allowed to appear in Back Paper Examination in maximum four papers of any semester of the course in which he/she has failed to obtain 40% marks in individual paper but has obtained 40% marks in aggregate of total marks.
- 14.5 **IMPROVEMENT :** A student shall be allowed to reappear in two papers for improving his marks/percentage after passing final semester examination in the next concerned examination. If a candidate has failed to avail the opportunity in the next concerned examination, his chance shall be treated as he has availed the opportunity. But this facility will be available to those candidates only who passes all semester examination in one attempt without availing the back paper facility. However the *interse* merit of the candidates shall be determined on the basis of marks obtained in first examination.

1. सभी प्रवेश लेने वाले छात्र/ छात्राओं को प्रवेश लेने के पश्चात उन्हें स्वयं परीक्षा फार्म ऑनलाइन भरना होगा एवं परीक्षा फार्म की हार्डकापी के साथ अंक तालिका तथा शुल्क जमा रसीद की छायाप्रति यहा विद्यालय में जमा करना होगा। परीक्षा फार्म भरने के लिए लखनऊ विद्यालय की वेब साइट पर स्वयं देखा जा सकता है और कॉलेज द्वारा निर्धारित जमा करने की तिथियों तक अवश्य ही भरना होगा।
2. प्रत्येक छात्र/ छात्रा का दायित्व होता है कि वह परीक्षा फार्म के विषय में विधिवत जानकारी प्राप्त करता रहे। परीक्षा फार्म न भर पाने की दशा में कालेज उत्तरदायी नहीं होगा।
3. प्रत्येक सेमेस्टर में प्रवेश लेना आवश्यक होता है और इस प्रोन्नत सेमेस्टर में परीक्षा फार्म भी उपरोक्त प्रकार से भरना होता है।
4. प्रवेश लेने के पश्चात परीक्षा फार्म स्वतः भरा हुआ नहीं समझ लेना चाहिये।
